ARGENTINA | 13 nights / 14 days

DAY 1: USA / BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA | Arrive in Buenos Aires and meet your private transfer to the contemporary *Four Seasons Buenos Aires*, indulging in your city view one-bedroom suite. Located in the heart of the city, unwind in world-class luxury for three nights and delight in exquisite Latin fare, pampering spa and an outdoor pool.

DAYS 2 - 4: BUENOS AIRES | Embark on the private guided *Classic City Experience*, learning of its rich history and culture. Stroll the Plaza de Mayo with its incredible architecture, statues and water fountains, visit colorful La Boca, the modern Puerto Madero and more. The following day, head to San Telmo, known as the “Tango District” for an exquisite *Dinner and Tango Show at La Ventana*.

DAYS 5 - 7: PUERTO IGUAZÚ | Take an early flight and arrive in this charming town. Check in to *Gran Meliá Iguazú* with its incredible waterfall views for three nights in a RedLevel suite with exclusive lounge access. Embark on the *Argentine Falls with Grand Adventure* experience. Marvel at the incredible sight of more than 275 falls with breathtaking views from the footbridges at Devil’s Throat Station, stroll the catwalks of The Superior Trail, then enjoy a thrilling boat ride at the canyon and through the rapids to Puerto Macuco.

DAY 8: PUERTO IGUAZÚ | Relish a leisurely day before an evening of wine and fine cuisine on the *Private Dinner and Wine Cocktail: Argentine Experience*. Savor a gourmet three-course meal, feasting on local favorites including empanadas, thick-cut fillet steaks and a sweet alfajores, vanilla biscuit with dulce de leche finish, all paired with fine Argentine wines.

DAYS 9 - 10: EL CALAFATE | Relax on your short flight and arrive at *Hotel Posada Los Alamos*. Replenish for two nights in your cozy suite with city views. The following day, delight in the *Private Perito Moreno Glacier with National Park and Boat Ride* adventure. Marvel at the impressive ice towering nearly 200 feet above sea level. Walk along catwalks with awe-inspiring views and thundering sounds, then board the Nautical Safari for an up close view of its peaks on this once-in-a-lifetime experience.

DAYS 11 - 12: USHUAIA | After your quick flight, check in to *Las Hayas Ushuaia Resort* for three nights in luxury suite. In the afternoon, discover unique wildlife on the *Beagle Channel Cruise, Bird Island and Sea Lions Island* adventure. Sail the Bay of Ushuaia with breathtaking city and mountain views through the Archipelago Bridges. Spot a diverse selection of sea birds including cormorants, albatrosses, ducks and seagulls, then visit Isla de Los Lobos and its vast colony of sea lions.

DAY 13: USHUAIA | Adventure abounds on the *Tierra del Fuego National Park and World’s End Train* experience. Known as the “Train of the End of the World,” relax on your locomotive steam trip with 360° views arriving at Pipo River and Macarena Waterfall. Continue via car learning of the Selk’nam aborigines, exploring the beaver dams of Lapataia River, concluding with stops at Cañadón del Toro and Lake Acigami.

DAY 14: USHUAIA / BUENOS AIRES | In the morning, board your private transfer to the airport for your return flights home and begin planning your next inspiring South American experience.

PERU | 10 nights / 11 days

DAY 1: USA / LIMA, PERU | Upon arrival in Lima, enjoy the scenic city sights on your private transfer to the *JW Marriott Hotel Lima*. DAY 4 - 5: LIMA, CUSCO & SACRED VALLEY | Fly to Cusco and embark on a half-day *Ancient Landmarks City Excursion*. Stroll cobblestone streets reveling in historical monuments including Santo Domingo Church and San Cristobal. Continue to the ceremonial compound of Sacsayhuamán Archaeological site and the Inca Baths of Tambomachay. In the evening, check in to *Tambo del Inka, A Luxury Collection Resort & Spa Valle Sagrado* for three nights in a contemporary junior suite.

DAY 6: SACRED VALLEY | Spend your day on the *Maras Salt pans, Moray Terraces and Ollantaytambo* excursion. Dating back thousands of years, the seemingly never-ending terraces of Maras Salt pans are still in use today. Admire the circular Moray Terraces, believed to have been an agricultural laboratory, astronomical observatory or place of worship ... or perhaps all three. Then, explore the citadel and fortress of Ollantaytambo.

DAYS 7 - 8: SACRED VALLEY & MACHU PICCHU | After checking in to *Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel* for two nights in an Inkaterra suite with private plunge pool, fireplace and outdoor shower, spend your days here on *Private Machu Picchu and Huayna Picchu Mountain* excursions with a personal local guide. Marvel at this breathtaking UNESCO World Heritage Site with a visit to the Citadel of Machu Picchu and climb to the towering peak of Huayna Picchu. Rising 8,972 feet above sea level, take in the stunning sights, explore the Temple of the Moon, and learn about its sacred temples, fine masonry and Inca history.

DAYS 9 - 10: MACHU PICCHU & CUSCO | Return to the city of Cusco and check in to the *JW Marriott El Convento Cusco* for two nights in a luxury suite. This restored 16th-century convent in the heart of the city is the ideal base for exploration. Relish a full-day *Piquillacta Ruins, Tipon Terraces and Andahuaylillas Church* tour. Discover this large Wari culture archaeological site south of Cusco, the remains of fountains and canals, polished stone walls and twelve terraces. Then, visit the town of Andahuaylillas, with its church known as the “Sistine Chapel of the Americans.” due to its decorated pichrome ceiling.

DAY 11: CUSCO & LIMA | Reminisce on your return flight to Lima and then home as you plan your next Latin adventure.
