



INSIDER TIPS

- Off the coast of Cape Town, Robben Island was often used as a prison, hospital and military base for centuries, and housed 20th-century political prisoners including Nelson Mandela. Don’t miss out on this current UNESCO World Heritage Site and museum. It is also home to protected seals, penguins and seabirds.
- Discover the days of the gold rush on the Witwatersrand at the Gold Reef City Amusement Park, with a visit to the gold mining museum in Johannesburg to see an ore vein or witness the pouring of molten gold into barrels.
- An annual event, the Mother City Queer Project in Cape Town is host to one of the grandest theme costume parties on the entire continent, celebrating LBGQTQ rights and featuring live music and a variety of festivities.
- Weekends come alive in Johannesburg with tourists and locals alike in the Market on Main in the Maboneng Precinct, featuring trendy shops, unique galleries, clubs and stores combined with international foods, music and fun vibes.

CAPE TOWN | 8 nights / 9 days

DAYS 1 - 2: CAPE TOWN | Upon arrival, be welcomed by a personal guide who will escort you through customs and immigration, plus assist with porters and transportation. Then, head to *One&Only Cape Town* for a splendid stay in a one-bedroom suite. Overlooking the harbor with panoramic Table Mountain views on the Victoria & Albert Waterfront, settle into elegant living with butler service and a private terrace.

DAYS 3 - 4: CAPE TOWN | Head out on the *Private Authentic City Excursion* to uncover Cape Town's history. See the parliament buildings and Slave Lodge before strolling the Grand Parade Square, Malay Quarter and meeting its Bo-Kaap people. Then, learn about diamond cutting and gold mining before a cable ride to the summit of Table Mountain.

The following day, unwind with a restorative swim in the pool or relax in a private cabana before heading to dinner. Indulge in Japanese-Peruvian culinary mastery from the Michelin-star chef restaurant Nobu.

DAYS 5 - 6: CAPE TOWN | Embark on a full day of exploration of notable wine regions and surroundings on the *Private Winelands Excursion*. Marvel at the untamed tranquility of the African wilderness, then return to the lodge for dinner under the stars in the treehouse-like restaurant.

DAYS 8 - 9: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK | Rise and shine for a sunrise guided 4x4 to ride out into the reserve and encounter wildlife firsthand, grazing in their habitat or relaxing at the water's edge. Be ready for elusive large cats including the spotted leopard or the fast-paced cheetah. Arrive back at the lodge for a late hearty breakfast with time to relax by the pool or rejuvenate with a spa treatment.

The next day, embark on a morning safari for a final exploration of this extraordinary expanse on the African continent. Celebrate nature and its creatures before your transfer to the airport for your flight home.

JOHANNESBURG | 7 nights / 8 days

DAYS 1 - 2: JOHANNESBURG | Be whisked away in your private transfer to the cliffside *Four Seasons Hotel The Westcliff, Johannesburg* for a peaceful escape, with panoramic balcony vistas and inspirational artisan appointments. Set overlooking the canopy, indulge in inspired dining at Flames restaurant, rejuvenating therapies at Aprés Spa and its al fresco spa lounge, two pools, vegetable garden and on-site jogging trail. Toast your arrival on the terrace of Flames and savor classic African barbecue fare.

DAY 3: JOHANNESBURG | Begin your day with a flavorful breakfast prior to meeting your guide for a *Private City Excursion*. Uncover the South Africa's struggling history and its current mission with a tour of Constitution Hill, the site of former prisons and military fort, now proudly a supreme Constitutional Court and living museum, experience a 100-year span from injustice to liberty. Then, learn about the gold rush days before heading to the revitalized Maboneng Precinct, with a drive through the upscale suburb of Houghton, once home to famed resident Nelson Mandela.

DAYS 4 - 5: JOHANNESBURG | Engage in a full day of South Africa's history and diamond operations on the guided *Private Pretoria & Cullinan Diamond Excursion*. From the ground to final cutting and polishing, discover the diamond mining process with a visit to an open cast mine. Then, explore the purple-lined streets of Jacaranda City and its inspiring landmarks before traveling to The Kruger Museum and Union buildings for a peek into past presidents.
