

Kyoto & Nara Experience | Uncover the history of Kinkakuji Temple, known as the Golden Pavilion before visiting Heian Jingu Shrine and its 82-foot torii gate. Visit Nara's 8th-century Todaiji Temple, and Kasuga Taisha Shrine where services and festivals are still held, and delight in free-roaming deer in Nara Park. | FD

Nikko Experience | A World Heritage site, discover the rich history, elaborate carvings and beautiful forest setting of the Nikko Toshogu Shrine and richly decorated Yomei Gate, designated as a national treasure, before visiting scenic Lake Chuzenji and famous Kegon Falls. | FD

KYOTO & OSAKA

Discover Kyoto Excursion | Explore the imposing Nijo Castle, and Kinkakuji Temple, also known as the Golden Pavilion, followed by a visit to the Heian Jingu Shrine and its iconic 82-foot torii gate. Hidden Kamakura & Enoshima Bay | Discover Kamakura's Jomyoji Temple with its stunning tearoom, for green matcha tea. Continue to ancient Hokuji Temple, its bamboo and Zen gardens, and Kotoku-in Temple with its monumental Buddha, before a Japanese-style lunch. Next, drive to Enoshima island, known for its hot springs, lighthouse and shrines. | **\$125** | FD, M

Kawagoe Ancient Edo Walking Experience & Street Food | Known as "Little Edo," this vibrant castle town boasts streets lined with clay warehouses, merchant homes and a Buddhist temple amid sweet shops, handicrafts and unique eateries. Sample traditional flavors from the ancient Edo period such as charcoal broiled eel, and tea ceremony dishes, with an opportunity to make sushi. | **\$55** | HD, M

Mount Fuji & Hakone Experience | Explore Hakone and Mount Fuji's famous 5th Station at an elevation of 7,550 feet, Japan's tallest mountain, its natural surroundings and stunning vistas. Then, cruise pristine Lake Ashi before a ride on Komagatake's Ropeway to the summit, offering amazing views of Hakone National Park. | **\$155** | FD, M

Nikko World Heritage Excursion | A World Heritage site, discover the rich history, elaborate carvings and beautiful forest setting of the Nikko Toshogu Shrine and treasured Yomei Gate. Break for a traditional Japanese lunch before visiting scenic Lake Chuzenji and famous Kegon Falls. | **\$137** | FD, M

Panoramic Tokyo Excursion | Begin at Meiji Jingu Shrine, honoring Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken with its distinguished forest of 100,000 trees. Continue to the Imperial East Garden and Tokyo's oldest Buddhist temple, Senso-ji, its giant red lantern and festive Nakamise Shopping Street. After lunch, delight in a bay cruise and visit to Odaiba. | **\$90** | FD, M

Sumo Tournament | An integral part of Japanese culture, learn about sumo history at the Sumo Museum.
